First Day of School Procedures

On the 1st day of school, 6th grade students will report to the cafeteria where they will receive a new copy of their schedule. A new schedule does not mean classes have changed, but please be aware that changes may take place the first few weeks of school to ensure we meet class size requirements. Teachers will pick up 6th grade students and walk them to 1st period. The tardy policy will not be enforced during the first week of school to alleviate anxiety. We want to help students locate classes without the fear of being tardy.

General Academic and Acceleration Information

All 6th grade students will take the following academic classes:

- English Language Arts (standard or advanced)
- Mathematics (standard, advanced, or 7th grade accelerated)
- Comprehensive Science 1 (standard or advanced) or Life Science
- World History advanced

While at Maitland Middle School, students have the option to take accelerated courses in an effort to earn high school credit. The following classes are high school courses and would reflect on a high school transcript/GPA:

All students will take a full year of Physical Education (PE) as required by Florida Statute.

A PE waiver is available from Mr. Singer and will be published on the MMS website once registration begins.

A student is eligible for a PE waiver if the student is participating in physical activities outside of the school day (excluding school programs), which are equal to or in excess of the mandated requirement.

Students who do not take PE will be scheduled into an additional elective class where space is available.
